Clarifications:

1. Will ECCTA please consider that stamped engineered drawings be submitted after award and final design approval instead of at the time proposals are due?

No. ECCTA needs stamped engineering drawings at the time of proposal in order to ensure compliance with the required standards and to meet acceptable public agency procurement standards.

2. Due to recent financial struggles in California, ECCTA has been advised that there will only be an initial funding amount of \$56,000 for this project. As funds are replenished by the state of California, ECCTA will continue to purchase bus shelters with amenities up to the \$200,000 earmarked for this project.

3. If a proposer has several different options of bus shelters with amenities to offer ECCTA, should the proposer submit more than one proposal?

No. Proposers may submit to ECCTA a "Request for Substitution" form located in the proposal documents by the due date listed in the proposal documents.

4. Where should the solar lighting batteries in the bus shelters be located?

In the safest out of public view location as possible.

5. Does ECCTA prefer an overall length of the shelter to be 12 feet or 14 feet long?

There is no preference. Either size will be acceptable.

6. Will any maps be installed on the shelters?

No.

7. Who owns ECCTA's current shelters with advertising on them?

Bay Area Transit Advertising owns such shelters. There is no affiliation with ECCTA although we do utilize them when appropriate.
