

# Transportation for LOS MEDANOS COLLEGE Brentwood

Thank you for riding with Tri Delta Transit. Following please find a brief overview of helpful information and resources to get your children to and from school.

## **BUS STOP LOCATIONS NEAR LOS MEDANOS COLLEGE**

For families that do not live near a bus stop served the route, you may be able to catch a different route and transfer.

**Tri MyRide**—depending on start and finish location within the Brentwood Zone.

#### **STAY CONNECTED:**



Our buses have free Wi-Fi!! Connect and then select the bus number on front of the bus by door.

## FIND A BUS STOP NEAR YOU:

Visit the website Local and Express Routes. Click on Bus Stop Locations. Find the stop near you, click on dot for what bus routes stops there and where the bus route goes.

## HERE'S HOW TO PLAN YOUR TRIP:



- Download the app TRANSIT for route planning, real time arrivals and schedule information. Use the bus ID# on the sign. Fee may be required.
- Go to www.trideltatransit.com on your phone or visit TriDeltaTransit.com website to view and print a route schedule. Pick up a printed schedule on a fixed route bus.

## TO FIND INFORMATION ON PASSES & FARES:

Tri Delta Transit accepts exact cash, Youth Clipper or Tri Delta Transit bus passes for fare payment. Non-exact cash will be given a credit ticket. Drivers do not carry cash for change. Visit the website page Fares/Passes.

 Make sure to arrive to your bus stop AT LEAST five (5) minutes early, safely stand where the driver can see you, and then make sure you are boarding the right bus!



All Tri Delta Transit buses are equipped with bike racks that fit two bikes. Bikes may be able to go on board if the front rack is full. Check with the bus operator.



Download the Tri MyRide app, register—then if you're in the zone, request a ride. Rides are shared and based on availability. See the website for details and cost per ride.
